EMB R8 TIES UP WITH EVSU FOR WORLD OZONE DAY

As part of its continued efforts to establish and enhance connections between environmental educators in region 8, the Environmental Management Bureau (EMB) has forged a partnership with the Eastern Visayas State University (EVSU) Main Campus for the celebration of World Ozone Day on September 16, 2022.

In collaboration with the Natural Sciences Department of the College of Arts and Sciences, EMB R8 will co-host the “Youth in Action: Key to Ozone Preservation” lecture-forum that will integrate topics such as ozone layer preservation, youth involvement in climate action, the national program on sustainable and eco-friendly schools, and the restoration of environmental values among the youth.

Selected EMB R8 personnel will act as speakers for the blended lecture-forum, which will be attended by all environmental science students in person and online.

EMB R8 and EVSU believe that this activity will further ensure greater engagement among the academic and youth sectors in championing environmental management as far as the ozone layer is concerned, so that more mitigating programs and initiatives will be implemented to combat climate change.

World Ozone Day, also known as the International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer, is observed on September 16 each year as declared by the United Nations General Assembly to commemorate the signing of the Montreal Protocol between 24 countries, which represents their commitment to rid the world of ozone-depleting substances.
